

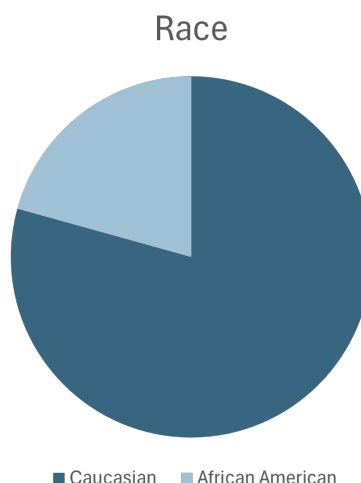
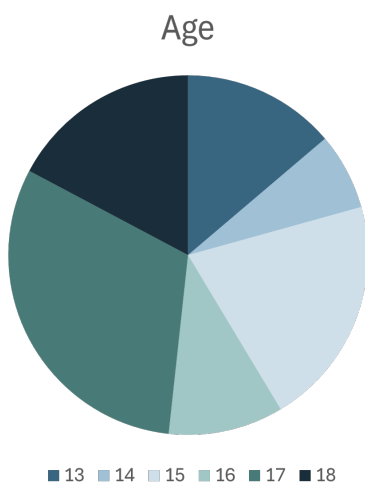
# WOODFORD HOME

## 2024 ANNUAL REPORT



Named after former ROP staff member and Indiana native, Larry Woodford, the Woodford Home is a Group Home licensed by the Indiana Department of Child Services as a Child Caring Institution serving male youth. The Woodford Home provides a safe therapeutic home for young men returning to the community from a residential placement.

### 2024 OUTCOMES

- 16 years old was the average age in 2024
- 5.2 hours of treatment per youth each week
- 317 family visits and home passes completed
- 21.9 hours of Positive Youth Development (PYD) activities provided per youth each week
